Gentlemen:

For 19 years, I have received an Annual Corporate Report in the form of a booklet. Each year, I filled out the enclosed report and sent a check to the State during the month of May.

This year, I did not receive a booklet—just a postcard with NO AMOUNT TO BE PAID—nor a report—to be found anywhere on the card. I sent a check on April 30, 2005 for \$125.00—the amount I thought I remembered to be the proper annual payment, and I checked the box that said that there were no changes in information. There was no report to fill out and accompany the check with—just the postcard which I filled out and sent with my check.

About a month later, I received a letter stating that I needed to fill out the accompanying report and sign it immediately, and there would be no late charge assessed. I immediately sent the signed report—accompanied by the letter. There was no mention of an additional \$25 due. If I had known, I most certainly would have included the additional nominal amount.

On June 21st, I received another letter contradicting the previous letter, stating that my report had not been filed, and assessing a \$400 late fee. This letter, and the report which I had signed and remitted just a week or two before, are enclosed again today.

For weeks, I have attempted, on numerous occasions, to contact someone at the number listed on the letters. Never have I been able to speak to a human voice, and was subjected to a circular system of computerized prompts and menus, which after a few minutes, invariably, led back to the initial recorded menu—If I wasn't disconnected totally—as I was on several frustrating occasions.

I have also just received a postcard saying "Notice of Intent to Dissolve".

Please, gentlemen!! I have been a hard-working, law-abiding businessman, who has always paid his taxes and filed his mandatory reports in a timely manner. I did so again this year—for the 19th consecutive year, but unexplained, ambiguous, and confusing changes in the State's method of collecting these taxes and report, combined with the inability to communicate directly with anyone who could explain and expedite these issues, have caused the situation to needlessly escalate to this point.

For nearly 3 months, I have tried to pay my taxes, file my report, and comply with the law in a timely manner. I have immediately complied with each request, despite their ambiguities and contradictions. I have attempted on numerous occasions to speak via phone, and now by letter. I hope, in the name of fairness, that you can understand my frustration with the system, and will accept this filing with the additional \$25 check enclosed without assessing an unconscionable \$400 fine and/or dissolving a nearly 20-year old corporation.
