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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF

The undersigned person hereby adopts these Articles of Organization in order to form a limited liability company under Chapter 608 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I - NAME


ARTICLE IX - ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS
