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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF WJ VENTURES, LLC, A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this limited liability company is WJ VENTURES, LLC, referred to in these Articles of Organization as the "Company."

ARTICLE II ADDRESS

ARTICLE V PURPOSE AND POWERS

This Company is organized with a general business purpose, has all powers provided by law and may use those powers to any lawful purpose.

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ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT BY MANAGERS

Section 6.01 Management Committee

The Company will be managed by a management committee, consisting of at least one manager, as provided for in the Operating Agreement. The names and addresses of the initial managers of the Company, which shall be two (2), are:

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Section 6.02 Authority of the Management Committee

- (a) Operational Authority of Managers. Except as provided in Section 6.02(b), in the Company's operating agreement of by resolution or written action of the management committee ω
- (i) the management committee, acting as a group, has sole authority to manage the Company and is authorized to make any contracts, enter into any transactions, and make and obtain any commitments on behalf of the Company to conduct or further the Company's business;
- (ii) each manager has one vote in management committee decisions;
- (iii) action by the management committee requires either

 (A) a properly called meeting of the managers, with
 a quorum present of both of the managers, and a resolution approved
 by the affirmative vote of both of the managers then present, or
 - (B) a written action, signed by both of the

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managers.

- (iv) The management committee may delegate to a subcommittee of managers, an individual manager, or an employee of the Company any of the management committee's responsibilities and authority. This provision does not alter or waive any duty that a manager may have to the Company concerning the manager's exercise of management authority.
- (b) Matters Reserved to the Members. Neither the management committee nor any delegate of the management committee has authority to sell substantially all of the Company assets, unless first authorized by members holding 75 percent of the voting power of the membership interests, with the authorization given either by vote at a properly called meeting of the members or by written consent.

RELATIONSHIP OF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION TO OPERATING AGREEMENT

If a provision of these Articles of Organization differs from a provision of the Company's operating agreement, then, to the extent allowed by law, these Articles will govern.
