ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

ARTICLE I NAME

Neither the management committee nor any delegate of the management committee has authority to sell substantially all of the Company assets, unless first authorized by members holding 75 percent of the voting power of the membership interests, with the authorization given either by vote at a properly called meeting of the members or by written consent.
