The Company will be a manager-managed company.

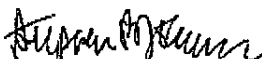
ARTICLE FIVE

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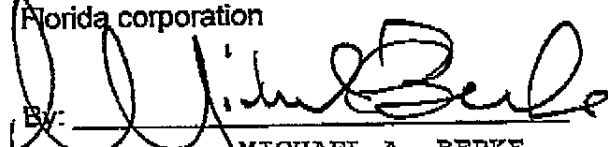
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ACCEPTANCE OF APPOINTMENT AS REGISTERED AGENT
