ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

FLY-N-FISH YACHT CHARTERS AND SALES, L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be FLY-N-FISH YACHT CHARTERS AND SALES, L.C.

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company shall be 19390 S. W. 232nd Street, Miami, Florida, 33170.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The company is organized for purposes as authorized by Chapter 608 of the Florida Statutes and these articles of organization.

ARTICLE IV - DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The company's existence shall be perpetual unless the company is earlier dissolved as provided in these articles of organization.

ARTICLE V - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the State of Florida is James F. Wyatt, 19390 S. W. 232nd Street, Miami, Florida, 33170.

ARTICLE VI - CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The members of the company shall contribute to the capital of the company the ash or property set forth in the Affidavit of Membership and Contributions attached hereto

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ARTICLE VII - ADDITIONAL CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Each member shall make additional capital contributions to the company only on the unanimous consent of all the members.

ARTICLE VIII - PROFITS AND LOSSES

Net profits and net losses shall be allocated to the members of the company proportionally in relation to the total capital contribution of each such member.

ARTICLE IX - ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional members shall be admitted to the company except with the unanimous written consent of all the members of the company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the members. A member may transfer his or her interest in the company as set forth in the regulations of the company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the company or become a member unless all the other members of the company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approve of the proposed transfer by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE X - TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The company shall be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or manager, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the company, unless the business of the company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, provided there are at least two remaining members.

ARTICLE XI - MANAGEMENT

The company shall be managed by a manager in accordance with regulations adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. These regulations may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the company not inconsistent with law or these articles of organization. The name and address of the initial manager of the company is James F. Wyatt, 19390 S. W. 232nd Street, Miami, Florida, 33170.
