ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

FINS DOCKSIDE FISH MARKET & OYSTER BAR, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statute 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the file Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I—NAME

The name of the Limited Liability Company shall be FINS DOCKSIDE FISH MARKET & OYSTER BAR, LLC- (hereinafter referred to as "the company").

ARTICLE II—ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company is 515 Seabreeze Blvd. Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33316.

ARTICLE III—DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date the Articles of Organization are filed with the Florida Department of State. The company's existence shall terminate not later than July 1, 2005 unless the company is dissolved earlier or these articles are amended to extend the termination date as provided in these Articles of Organization, the Limited Liability Company Agreement and/or other such regulations.

ARTICLE IV—REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the State of Florida are DOLORES K. SANCHEZ, P.A., 4701 N. Federal Highway, Suite 316, Lighthouse Point, FL 33064.

ARTICLE V—CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The members of the company shall contribute to the capital of the company the cash or property as set forth in the regulations and/or Limited Liability Company Agreement.

ARTICLE VI—ADDITIONAL CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Each member shall make additional capital contributions to the company only on the unanimous consent of all members, or as provided in the regulations.

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ARTICLE VII—ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

Except as set forth in the regulations, no additional members shall be admitted to the company except with the required written consent of members of the company holding at least 80% of the units of the company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by the members or regulations. All members must become a party to the Limited Liability Company Agreement which outlines the rules and regulations of the company. A member may transfer his or her interest in the company as set forth in the Limited Liability Company Agreement or other such regulations of the company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the company or become a member unless the requisite members of the company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approve of the proposed transfer by written consent.

ARTICLE VIII—MEMBERS' RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

The company shall be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or manager, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the company, unless the business of the company is continued by vote of the remaining members holding at least 80% of the remaining units.

ARTICLE IX—MANAGEMENT

The company shall be managed by the members in accordance with regulations adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. These regulations may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the company not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Organization. The name and address of one of the initial managing members (profit members) of the company is Shirley Whelan 515 Seabreeze Blvd., Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33316.



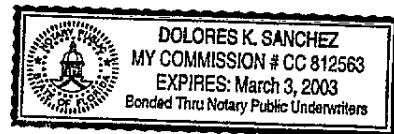
