### ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

### MONASTERY GOLF GROUP, L.C.,

### A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

Pursuant to the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes, Chapter 608, the undersigned, acting as organizer of a limited liability company, hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for such Company:

#### Article I Name

The name of the limited liability company is MONASTERY GOLF GROUP, L.C. (the "Company").

### Article II Company Existence

The Company's existence shall be perpetual and shall be effective upon the filing of these Articles of Organization with the Florida Secretary of State.

# Article III Units Of Equity Ownership

Section A. Authorized Units of Equity Ownership. The maximum number of units are equity ownership units the Company is authorized to have outstanding is 1,000 units, all of which shall be identical units.

Section B. Restrictions on Disposition of Units. The Company shall, to the fullest extent authorized by the Florida Statutes, as the same may be amended from time to time, indemnify any Member and/or Member-Manager who is of was a party, or who is threatened to be made a party, to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, including all appeals, by reasons of the fact that such Member and/or Member-Manager is or was a Member, Manager, Officer or employee of the Company, or is or was serving at the request of the Company as a director, Trustee, officer or employee of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, depust or other enterprise, against any and all expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees), judgments, decrees, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement, which were actually and reasonably inedfred by such Member and/or Member-Manager in connection with such action, suit or proceeding. The Company shall not indemnify any Member and/or Member-Manager in the event of (i) a breach of such Member and/or Member-Manager's duty of loyalty to the Company or its Members, (ii) acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of the law, (iii) a transaction from which such Member and/or Member-Manager derived an improper personal benefit, or (iv) acts or omissions for which indemnification is prohibited under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, or (v) judgments, penalties, fines, and settlements arising from any proceeding by or in the right of the Company, or against expenses in any such case where such Member and/or Member-Manager shall be adjudged liable to the Company. The indemnification provided in this Article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which a person indemnified may be entitled under any agreement, vote of Members, or disinterested Officers or otherwise, both as to action in the official capacity of such person and as to action in another capacity while holding such office, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be an Officer or a Member and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors, and administrators

of such person.

### Article XI Real Estate Documents

All conveyances and mortgages of and leases relating to real property made by the Company shall be executed by a Manager of the Company, and all releases of mortgages, liens, judgments, or other claims that are required by law to be made of record shall be executed by a Manager of the Company.

# Article XII <u>Members' Right to Continue Business</u>

The right of the remaining Members to continue the business of the Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a Member, or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a Member in the Company, shall, provided there shall be at least one (1) Member remaining with ownership interest in the Company, be determined by the remaining Members in accordance with Florida law.
