ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF GREGORY S. PARKER, ATTORNEY AT LAW, P.L.

The undersigned certify that he organized himself and his law firm for the purpose of becoming a professional limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. The undersigned further declares that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the professional limited liability company. SEP -6 PM 2: 43

ARTICLE I NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

FILED

The name of the limited liability company shall be GREGORY S. PARKER, ATTORNEY A LAW, P.L., and its principal office shall be located at 315 W. GREEN ST., in the City of Perry, County of Taylor, State of Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the members may designate. ARTICLE III EXERCISE OF POWERS

Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company. A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with unanimous written consent of all its members.

On the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business on unanimous consent of the remaining members.

ARTICLE VI PROFITS AND LOSSES

(a) Profit Sharing.
