ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

I.

The name of the Limited Liability Company shall be Storm Radar, L.L.C..

II.

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the Limited Liability Company shall be: 520 Santa Rosa Boulevard, Suite 414, Fort Walton Beach, Florida 32548.

III.

The registered agent for the Limited Liability Company shall be: Scott P. Stevens and the Florida street address for the registered agent is: 520 Santa Rosa Boulevard, Suite 414, Fort Walton Beach, Florida 32548.

Having been named as registered agent and to accept service of process for the above stated limited liability company at the place designated in this certificate. I hereby accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity. I further agree to comply with the provisions of all statutes relating to the proper and complete performance of my duties, and I am familiar with and accept the obligations of my position as registered agent as provided for in Chapter 608, F.S.

Storm is formed in order to conduct all manner of for profit enterprises and will not be limited to the provision of weather radar services. Initial ownership of Storm Radar, L.E. shall be vested in its two members: Scott P. Stevens and Barney Timon Ware, III. The individual constituents of Storm shall not be held individually liable for acts within their individual capacity as managing members of the limited liability company and will be held harmless and indemnified for all such acts, whether deemed to be negligent, grossly negligent, reckless or otherwise by the company to the fullest extent permitted by law.

The effective date for these Articles of Organization shall be October 1, 2000.
