Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 607.1109 and 608.438, Florida Statutes, BankAtlantic Financial Technology Venture Partners, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, as the Surviving Entity in a Merger, hereby submits the following Articles of Merger:

- 1. <u>Parties to the Merger</u>: The names of the entities which are parties to the merger (the "<u>Merger</u>") contemplated by these Articles of Merger are BFC Venture Partners, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "<u>Merging Corporation</u>"), and BankAtlantic Financial Technology Venture Partners, LLC, a Florida limited liability company. The Surviving Entity in the Merger is BankAtlantic Financial Technology Venture Partners, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (the "<u>Surviving Entity</u>").
- 2. <u>Plan of Merger</u>: The plan of merger is set forth in an Agreement and Plan of Merger, dated as of <u>Normace 3</u>, 2000, between the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity (the "<u>Agreement of Merger</u>"), a copy of which Agreement of Merger is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 3. Approval: The Agreement of Merger was approved and adopted by (a) the sole shareholder and board of directors of Merging Corporation on <u>Movembel</u> 3, 2000 in accordance with applicable provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, F.S. Chapter 607, and (b) the sole Member and management committee of the Surviving Entity on <u>Movembel</u> 3, 2000 in accordance with the provisions of the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608.
- 4. <u>Effective Date</u>: The Merger shall become effective upon the filing of these Articles of Merger with the Florida Department of State.

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EXHIBIT A

AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER

THIS AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER (the "Agreement") made and entered into this <u>Acc</u> day of <u>Movembee</u>, 2000 by and between:

BFC Venture Partners, Inc., a Florida corporation with its principal office located at 1750 East Sunrise Boulevard, Fon Lauderdale, Florida, 33304 (hereinafter referred to as the "Merging Corporation"),

and

BankAtlantic Financial Technology Venture Partners, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, with its principal office located at 1750 East Sunrise Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33304 (hereinafter referred to as the "Surviving Entity").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Merging Corporation is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Surviving Entity is a limited liability company duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to duly authorized action by their respective Board of Directors, Shareholders, Management Committee and Members, as applicable, the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity have determined that they shall merge (the "Merger") upon the terms and conditions and in the manner set forth in this Agreement and in accordance with Section 608.438 of the Florida Limited Liability Company Act and Section 607.1108 of the Florida Business Corporation Act;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual premises herein contained, the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity hereby agree as follows:

- 1. MERGER. The Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity agree that the Merging Corporation shall be merged with and into the Surviving Entity, as a single and surviving entity, upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and that the Surviving Entity shall continue under the laws of the State of Florida as the surviving entity.
 - SURVIVING ENTITY. On and after the effective date of the Merger:
 - (a) The Surviving Entity shall be the surviving entity, and shall continue to exist as a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, with all of the right and obligations of such Surviving Entity as are provided by the Florida Limited Liability Company Act.

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- (b) The Merging Corporation shall cease to exist, and its property shall become the property of the Surviving Entity as the Surviving Entity.
- 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MERGER. The terms and conditions of the Merger are the following:
 - ____ (a) Operating Agreement. The Operating Agreement of the Surviving Entity shall continue as the Operating Agreement of the Surviving Entity.
- 4. MANNER AND BASIS OF CONVERTING SHARES INTO SURVIVING ENTITY. The issued and outstanding shares and rights to acquire shares of the Merging Corporation shall be converted as follows:
 - (a) Each and every share of common stock in the Merging Corporation and each right to acquire shares of common stock or other securities of the Merging Corporation shall be canceled and no longer be issued or outstanding, and no membership interests in the Surviving Entity will be issued in respect thereof; and
 - (b) The member of the Surviving Entity shall remain the member of the Surviving Entity.
- 5. APPROVAL. The Merger contemplated by this Agreement has previously been submitted to and approved by the respective Board of Directors, Shareholders, Management Committee or Members, as the case may be, of the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity. Subsequent to the execution of this Agreement by the appropriate officers of the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Entity, the proper officers of the Merging Corporation and the Surviving entity shall, and are hereby authorized and directed to, perform all such further acts and execute and deliver to the proper authorities for filing all documents, as the same may be necessary or proper to render effective the Merger contemplated by this Agreement.
- 6. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE OF MERGER</u>. The Merger shall be effective upon the filing by the Surviving Entity of Articles of Merger relating to the Merger with the Department of State of the State of Florida.

7. <u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>.

- (a) Governing Law. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
- (b) No Third Party Beneficiaries. The terms and conditions of this Agreement are solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and the shareholders of the Merging Corporation and the members of the Surviving Entity, and no person not a party to this Agreement shall have any rights or benefits whatsoever under this Agreement, either as a third party beneficiary or otherwise.

(c) <u>Management of the Surviving Entity</u>. The names and addresses of the Members of the Management Committee of the Surviving Entity are:
