FIRST AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF CONNERTON, LLC

Before the company issues any membership interests, the members shall determine that the consideration received or to be received for such membership interests to be issued is adequate. All membership interests when so issued, and the consideration therefore received by the Company, shall be fully paid and shall be non-assessable."
