ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF CATHOLICWEB.COM, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be CATHOLICWEB.COM, L.L. ("Company").

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the Company in Florid shall be 2000 Alden Street, Orlando, FL 32803-1459.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The period of duration of the Company shall be perpetual commencing on the date these Articles of Organization are filed by the Florida Department of State unless the Company is earlier dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization or the Operating Agreement of the Company.

ARTICLE VIII - MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be managed by one or more managers in accordance with the Operating Agreement adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company. The Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE IX - RETURN OF CAPITAL

No member may demand return of capital contributions except as may be provided in the Operating Agreement of the Company.
