ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF

The undersigned, hereby certify association for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and communities of limited liability companies for profit. It is further declared that the following Amended and Restated Articles shall be the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of said limited liability company. The original Articles of Organization were filed on December 28, 2000, Document Number L01000000019.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this limited liability company shall be 2701 Building, LLC, and its principal place of business shall be in Ocala, County of Marion, State of Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as may be designated by the members.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department thereof, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, rescind any of such contracts.

5. 6. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

7. The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.





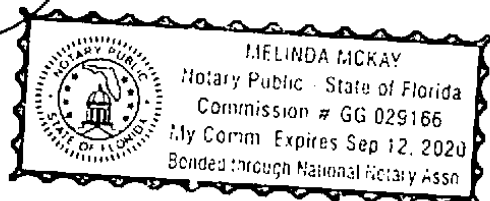
