## ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

#### DOWNTOWN AT THE GARDENS, LLC

I, the undersigned natural person competent to contract, hereby organize and form a limited liability company of which I will be a member under and pursuant to Chapter 608, Florida Statutes as follows:

#### ARTICLE 1.

## Name of Limited Liability Company

The name of this limited liability company shall be Downtown At The Gardens, LLC.

#### ARTICLE 2.

#### Period of Duration

The existence of the Company shall be perpetual from the date of filing these Articles with the Department of State terminated by vote of the members.
