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# ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF SARMIENTO ADVERTISING GROUP, L.L.C.

The undersigned hereby certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall be the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of such limited liability company.

or department thereof, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel or rescind any of such contracts.

- 5.
