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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

FOR

CC & J, LLC

The undersigned, acting as the organizing Member of a Limited Liability Company to be formed under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, as Amended (the "Act"), hereby forms a Florida Limited Liability Company (the "Company") pursuant to the Act, and hereby sets forth the following Articles of Organization (the "Articles"):

ARTICLE I

Name

The Name of the Company is CC & J, LLC.

ARTICLE II

Commencement Date and Duration

The Company's existence shall commence on the date these Articles are filed with the Florida Department of State, and shall continue for a period of fifty (50) years from the commencement date unless sooner dissolved in accordance with Section 608.441 of the Act.

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ARTICLE III

Purpose

The Company is created to acquire, hold, manage, operate, improve, develop, lease, sell, dispose of, mortgage or otherwise encumber, and otherwise deal in the retail restaurant business, and all matters related or associated therewith, and further to engage in any other lawful activity.

ARTICLE IV

Principal Office

The mailing address and the street address of the principal office of the Company shall be 1206 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida 34205.

ARTICLE V

Registered Agent and Office

The initial registered agent for the Company shall be G. Joseph Harrison, and the address of the registered agent for service of process shall be 1206 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Manatee County, Florida 34205.

ARTICLE VI

Management of Business

The Company is to be managed by a manager or managers. Connie Baxter, 3618 75th Avenue Terrace East, Sarasota, Florida 34243, will serve as the initial manager of the Company until the first annual meeting of the Members or until its successor is elected and qualified. The managers of the Company will be elected annually by the Members. The Members may increase and decrease the number of managers from time to time; provided, however, there shall never be

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more than three (3) managers or less than one (1) manager. The managers shall be Members or Affiliates of Members.

ARTICLE VII

Admission of Additional Members

Additional Members may be admitted only by the vote of the Members holding a majority of the Units, upon terms and conditions established by the Members from time to time in their sole discretion.

ARTICLE VIII

Continuation of Business

The remaining Members shall have the right to continue the business of the Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of any Member, or upon the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a Member of the Company, all as more fully set forth in the Regulations.

ARTICLE IX

Powers

The Company shall have all of the powers and authority set forth in Section 608.404 of the Act.

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ARTICLE X

Property

(a) Ownership. All property originally paid or transferred to the Company as contributions to capital by the Members, or subsequently acquired by purchase or otherwise on account of the Company, shall be the property of the Company.

(b) Title. The title to all property of the Company shall be held in the name of the Company.

(c) Conveyances. Notwithstanding any provision of these Articles or any provision of any statutes, no manager may convey or encumber title to all real and personal property of the Company without the written consent of all Members. Upon obtaining such consent, the Managers are hereby authorized to convey or encumber title to all real and personal property of the Company by the execution on behalf of the Company of any and all agreements, deeds, mortgages, trust agreements, indentures, leases, conveyance documents, and all other certificates, instruments, and documents as are necessary, reasonable, or desirable to convey or encumber title to any real or personal property of the Company. Such execution shall be made by any manager duly authorized to act for the Company. The signature and execution of such documents shall clearly set forth that the execution is on behalf of the Company, and that the manager is signing on behalf of the Company.

ARTICLE XI

Amendments

These Articles may be amended or restated at any time by a vote of the Members holding a majority of the Units, and such amendment or restatement shall be filed with the Florida Department of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 608.411 of the Act.

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ARTICLE XII

Regulations

Regulations shall be prepared and adopted to govern the internal affairs of the Company containing such provisions as may be necessary, reasonable, or desirable, except that no provision of such Regulations may conflict with the provisions of these Articles unless permitted herein. The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal the Regulations shall be set forth in the Regulations.

ARTICLE XIII

Contracting Debts

No debt shall be contracted nor liability incurred by or on behalf of the Company except by its managers, and no Member is authorized or empowered to contract debts or incur liabilities on behalf of the Company unless such Member is also a manager.

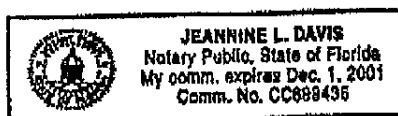
