**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
LENOX WEST, L.L.C.**

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company is Lenox West, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II

ADDRESS

The principal office and mailing address of the limited liability company shall be 2513 St. Michel Court, Ponte Vedra, Florida 32082.

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The duration of the limited liability company shall be perpetual, and shall commence on the date these Articles are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five days, exclusive of legal holidays, after they are executed and acknowledged, the company's existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

ARTICLE IV

MANAGEMENT

The managing member shall be Jon E. Crabtree, whose address is 2513 St. Michel Court, Ponte Vedra, Florida 32082. The authority of the managing member and the other members to make certain decisions on behalf of the limited liability company shall be governed by the regulations of the company, as they exist from time to time.

ARTICLE V

ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

No person may be admitted as a member unless each member consents in writing to the admission of the additional member.

MEMBERS' RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

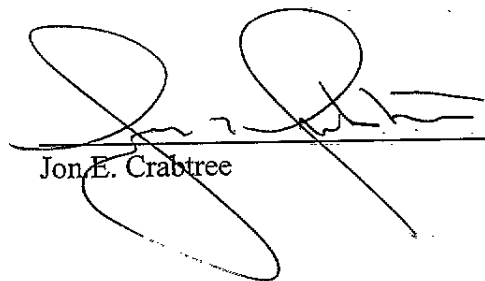

ARTICLE VII

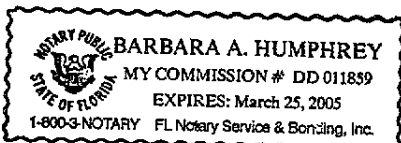

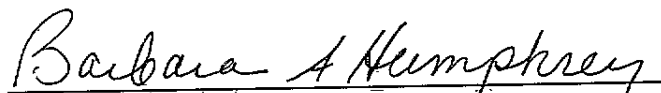

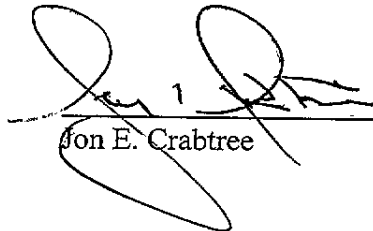
