ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF LAW OFFICES OF CHUN-TE WU, P.L.

The undersigned, being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the State of Florida, for the purpose of forming a professional limited liability company under the Professional Service Corporations and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 621, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be LAW OFFICES OF CHUN-TE WU, P.L., hereinafter referred to as "company".

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS
