ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

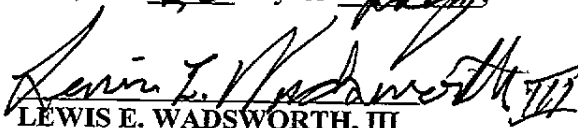
