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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF LAS OLAS PLACE II, LLC

FILED SECRETARY OF STATE DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS

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(A Florida Limited Liability Company)

- 1. The name of the Limited Liability Company is Las Olas Place II, LLC (the "Company").
- 2. The Articles of Organization were filed on September 6, 2001, and assigned document number L01000015262.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 608.411, Florida Statutes, the Articles of Organization of the Limited Liability Company are hereby amended by the deletion of Article III, "Nature of Business and Mailing Address," and the substitution therefor of the following:

"ARTICLE III NATURE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The Company's business and purpose shall consist solely of the acquisition, ownership, operation and management of the real estate project known as Himmarshee Landings, located in Fort Lauderdale, Florida (the "Property") and such activities as are necessary, incidental or appropriate in connection therewith.

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the Limited Liability Company is 912 East Las Olas Boulevard, Suite A, Fon Landerdale, Florida, 33301."

4. Pursuant to Section 608.411, Florida Statutes, the Articles of Organization of the Limited Liability Company are hereby further amended by the addition of the following:

"ARTICLE VII POWERS AND DUTIES

(a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Company's Articles of Organization and any Amendments thereto and/or Operating Agreement and so long as any obligations secured by that certain Loan Agreement/Mortgage dated on or about November 10, 2005, in favor of General Electric Capital Corporation, as lender (the "Mortgage") remain outstanding and not discharged in full, without the prior written consent of the holder of the Mortgage, the Managing Member and the Company shall have no authority to:

- trade accounts payable and lease obligations in the normal course of business, or grant consensual liens on the Company's Property; except, however, that the Managing Member is hereby authorized to secure financing for the Company pursuant to the terms of the Mortgage and other indebtedness expressly permitted therein or in the documents related to the Mortgage, and to grant a mortgage, lien or liens on the Company's Property to secure such Mortgage;
- (ii) dissolve or liquidate the Company;
- (iii) sell or lease, or otherwise dispose of all or substantially all of the assets of the Company;
- (iv) amend, modify or alter Articles III, VII, VIII, IX and X of these Articles of Organization and any Amendments thereto or Section 2.4 and Articles XIV-XVII of this Operating Agreement; or
- (v) merge or consolidate with any other entity.
- (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing and so long as any obligation secured by the Mortgage remains outstanding and not discharged in full, the Managing Member and the Company shall have no authority, unless such action has been approved by the unanimous vote of the Managing Member's Board of Directors and the unanimous consent of all other Members, file a voluntary petition or otherwise initiate proceedings to have the Company adjudicated bankrupt or insolvent, or consent to the institution of bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings against the Company, or file a petition secking or consenting to reorganization or relief of the Company as debtor under any applicable federal or state law relating to bankruptcy, insolvency, or other relief for debtors with respect to the Company; or seek or consent to the appointment of any trustce, receiver, conservator, assignee, sequestrator, custodian, liquidator (or other similar official) of the Company or of all or any substantial part of the properties and assets of the Company, or make any general assignment for the benefit of creditors of the Company, or admit in writing the inability of the Company to pay its debts generally as they become due or declare or effect a moratorium on the Company debt or take any action in furtherance of any action.
- (c) So long as any obligation secured by the Mortgage remains outstanding and not discharged in full, the Company shall have a corporate managing member having articles of incorporation containing the restrictions and terms set forth in Articles II, VIII and IX of the

Managing Member's Articles of Incorporation and any Amendments thereto as of the date hereof, and the Company shall have no other managing members.

ARTICLE VIII TITLE TO COMPANY PROPERTY

All Property owned by the Company shall be owned by the Company as an entity and, insofar as permitted by applicable law, no Member shall have any ownership interest in any Company Property in its individual name or right, and each Member's Membership Interest shall be personal property for all purposes.

ARTICLE IX SEPARATENESS/OPERATIONS MATTERS

The Company shall:

- (a) maintain books and records and bank accounts separate from those of any other person;
- (b) maintain its assets in such a manner that it is not costly or difficult to segregate, identify or ascertain such assets;
- (c) hold regular meetings, as appropriate, to conduct the business of the Company, and observe all customary organizational and operational formalities;
- (d) hold itself out to creditors and the public as a legal entity separate and distinct from any other entity;
- (e) prepare separate tax returns and financial statements, or if part of a consolidated group, then it will be shown as a separate member of such group;
- (f) allocate and charge fairly and reasonably any common employee or overhead shared with affiliates:
- (g) transact all business with affiliates on an arm's-length basis and pursuant to enforceable agreements;
- (h) conduct business in its own name, and use separate stationery, invoices and checks;
- (i) not commingle its assets or funds with those of any other person;
- (j) not assume, guarantee or pay the debts or obligations of any other person;
- (k) correct any known misunderstanding as to its separate identity;

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- (l) not permit any affiliate to guarantee or pay its obligations (other than limited guarantees set forth in the Mortgage or related documents); and
- (m) not make loans or advances to any other person.

ARTICLE X

EFFECT OF BANKRUPTCY, DEATH OR INCOMPETENCY OF A MEMBER

The bankruptcy, death, dissolution, liquidation, termination or adjudication of incompetency of a Member shall not cause the termination or dissolution of the Company and the business of the Company shall continue. Upon any such occurrence, the trustee, receiver, personal representative, executor, administrator, committee, guardian or conservator of such Member shall have all the rights of such Member for the purpose of settling or managing its estate or Property, subject to satisfying conditions precedent to the admission of such assignee as a substitute Member. The transfer by such trustee, receiver, executor, administrator, committee, guardian or conservator of any Company interest shall be subject to all of the restrictions, hereunder to which such transfer would have been subject if such transfer had been made by such bankrupt, deceased, dissolved, liquidated, terminated or incompetent Member. The foregoing shall apply to the extent permitted by applicable law.
