ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION CARDINAL CONFIDENTIAL, L. L. C.

The undersigned member, desiring to form CARDINAL CONFIDENTIAL. L.L.C., under and pursuant to Chapter 608, Florida Statues, entitled the Florida Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"), does hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for such Company:
