ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
MISSISSIPPI RODNEY LANDS, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be MISSISSIPPI RODNEY LANDS, LLC ("company").

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company is:

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State or on another effective date as specified. The company's existence shall be perpetual unless the company is dissolved earlier as provided in these articles of organization or in the regulations.

ARTICLE IV -- REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the state of Florida are:

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ARTICLE V -- ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

Except as set forth in the regulations, no additional members shall be admitted to the company except with the unanimous written consent of all the members of the company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the members. A member may transfer his, her, or its interest in the company as set forth in the regulations of the company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the company or become a member unless all of the members of the company other than the member proposing to dispose of his, her, or its interest approve of the proposed transfer by written consent.

ARTICLE VI -- MEMBERS' RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

The company shall be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or manager, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the company, unless the business of the company is continued by majority vote of all the remaining members, the vote of each member being equal. For purposes of this Article only, a vote of fifty (50%) percent of the members in favor of continuing business shall be deemed to be a majority.

ARTICLE VII -- MANAGEMENT

With the exception of the authority provided in Article VIII below, the company shall be managed by the members in accordance with regulations adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. These regulations may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the company not inconsistent with law or these articles of organization. 
