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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

FRANCINE GROSS, M.D., PROFESSIONAL L.L.C.

I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that I have associated myself together for the purpose of becoming a professional limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and communities of limited liability companies for profit. I further declare that the following Articles shall be the charter and authority for the conduct of business of said professional limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

<u>NAME</u>
