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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF Q Enterprises, LLC

ARTICLE I Name of Company

Q Enterprises, LLC

ARTICLE II Business of Organization

The limited liability company may engage in the business of real estate management, and leasing, and may also engage in any other lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III Principal Place of Business

The principal place of business of the limited liability company shall be: 2747
