ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME
