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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF WANES, BRETTMANN & MORGAN, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be Wanes, Brettmann & Morgan, LLC.

ARTICLE TWO ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the company is 2395 Hawthorne Drive, Clearwater, FL 33763.

ARTICLE THREE DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State or on another effective date if specified. ARTICLE TEN MEDIATION AND ARBITRATION

Any disputes between the members, whether arising under these articles of organization or otherwise, which the members cannot resolve between themselves using good faith shall be:

(A) Referred to a court certified mediation of the Circuit Court in the county of the principal moffice of the company, and any mediation shall be held in the county of the principal office of the

Judgment upon the award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 682, as amended, The Arbitration Code.
- (C) If any member refuses to comply with a ruling or decision of the arbitrator and lawsuit is brought to enforce said ruling or decision, it is agreed that the member not complying with the ruling or decision of the arbitrator shall pay the court costs and reasonable attorney's fees (including trial and appellate attorney's fees) incurred in the enforcing of the ruling or decision of the arbitrator.
- (D) Any rights of injunctive relief shall be in addition to and not in derogation or limitation of any other legal rights.
