ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF BIRD & LEINBACK, P. L.

The undersigned hereby certifies that the members named herein have associated together for the purpose of becoming a Professional Limited Liability Company under Florida Statutes Chapters 608 and 621, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of professional limited liability companies for profit, and the following Articles of Organization are hereby adopted.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the Professional Limited Liability Company shall be **BIRD & LEINBACK**, **P. L.**

ARTICLE II. DURATION; EFFECTIVE DATE

This Professional Limited Liability Company shall exist for a period commencing as of the later of January 1, 2002 or the date on which these Articles of Organization are filed with the State of Florida Department of State and terminating on December 31, 2024.

ARTICLE III. ADDRESS; PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The mailing address of the Professional Limited Liability Company and the street address of the principal office Limited Liability Company is 385 N. Jefferson Street, Monticello, Florida 32344.

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of the Professional Limited Liability Company is 385 N. Jefferson Street, Monticello, Florida and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is T. Buckingham Bird.

ARTICLE V. PURPOSE

This Professional Limited Liability Company is organized for the following purposes:

A. To engage in every aspect of the practice of law and the performance of services ancillary thereto.

- B. To render professional services in connection with the practice of law by and through its members, officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services within the State of Florida.

- F. ARTICLE VI. RESTRICTIONS ON MEMBERSHIP; RIGHT TO ADMIT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Individual members of this Professional Limited Liability Company must be licensed to practice law in the State of Florida. The shareholders of any member that is a professional service corporation and the members of any member that is a professional limited liability company and individual partners or the shareholders of any professional service corporation partner of a partnership that is a member must each be licensed to practice law in the State of Florida. Existing members shall have the right to admit new members by consent of members representing eighty percent (80%) of the ownership interest in this Professional Limited Liability Company. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the Professional Limited Liability Company in accordance with the Regulations.

A member's interest in the Professional Limited Liability Company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except to a person licensed to practice law in the State of Florida, with written consent of members representing eight percent (80%) of the ownership interests in this Professional Limited Liability Company and otherwise in accordance with the Regulations of this Professional Limited Liability Company.

ARTICLE VII. CONTINUATION

Upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in this Professional Limited Liability Company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business upon unanimous consent of such remaining members.

ARTICLE VIII. MANAGEMENT

Management of the Limited Liability Company is reserved to its members and the names and addresses of the initial members are as follows:
