ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR FLORIDA PROFESSIONAL LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

The undersigned person, desiring to form a professional limited liability company pursuant to the provisions of the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, hereby submits these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the professional limited liability company shall be: **REDMAN, HINES & NORMAN, P.L.**

ARTICLE II - Address

The mailing and street address of the principal office of the professional limited liability company shall be:

Plant City, FL 33566

ARTICLE III - Effective Date

The professional limited liability company shall commence to exist on April 1, 2002.

ARTICLE IV - Nature of Business

The general nature of business to be transacted by the professional limited liability company, or the objects or purposes of the professional limited liability company, shall be as follows:

- (a) To engage solely and specifically in the business of carrying on the practice of law.
- (b) To invest in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investments.
- (c) To own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of the above professional services.
- (d) In general, to have and exercise all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon professional service corporations, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

ARTICLE V - Management

The professional limited liability company shall be managed by its members.

ARTICLE VI - Membership Units

The total number of membership units authorized to be issued by the professional limited liability company shall be 10,000 units, par value \$.01. Each of the said units shall entitle the holder thereof to one (1) vote at any meeting of the members. All or any part of said units may be paid for in cash, in property, or in labor or services at a fair valuation to be fixed by the managers of the professional limited liability company at a meeting called for such purposes. All membership units then issued shall be paid for and shall be nonassessable. The professional limited liability company elects to have preemptive rights governed in accordance with Section 607.0630 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VII - Ownership

The initial members of the professional limited liability company, and their respective ownership interests, shall be as follows:

ARTICLE VIII - Admission of Additional Members

The members may admit additional members. An additional member may be admitted pursuant to the unanimous consent of the members in existence prior to the admission of any such additional member. However, no individual may be admitted as a member unless such individual is duly licensed and otherwise legally authorized to render legal services, and no entity may be admitted as a member unless such entity is a professional service corporation or a professional limited liability company that is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render legal services.

ARTICLE IX – Right of Members to Continue Business


The remaining member or members of the professional limited liability company, if any, shall be entitled to continue the business on the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member in the professional limited liability company.

ARTICLE X - Registered Agent, Registered Office, and Resident Agent's Signature


