company. The authority of the managers shall be exercised in accordance with the operating agreement of the limited liability company.

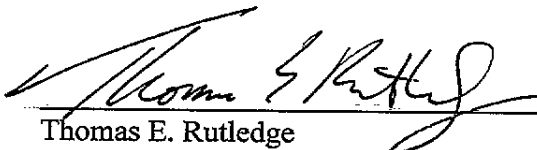
Article V

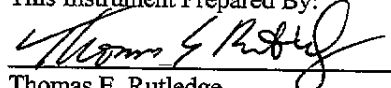
Article VI
