ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

<u>OF</u>

DISCOVERY ART INTERNATIONAL, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I

The name of this limited liability company is DISCOVERY ART INTERNATIONAL, L.L.C., with its principal office located at 5431 Ward Lake Drive, Port Orange, Florida 32127.

ARTICLE II

This company shall exist until dissolved in a manner provided by law, or as provided in the regulations adopted by the members.

ARTICLE III

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this limited liability company is as follows:

- (a). To transact any and all lawful business for which companies may be organized under the laws of the State of Florida.
- (b). To design, manufacture, buy and sell, import and generally deal in artwork, hand carved exotic woods, reproductions, and all other related items, and to generally conduct the business of importing all such items into the United States for retail and wholesale distribution.
- (c). To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, affixed, or in any manner reproduced.
- (d). To purchase, take, receive, lease, sub-lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with the real and personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- (e). To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of all or part of its property and assets.
- (f). To make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the limited liability company may determine, issue its notes, bonds,

and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or please of all or any of its property, franchises and income.

- (g). To lend money for its business purposes, invest and reinvest its funds fatth and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- (h). To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this act within or without this state.
- (i). To make distribution for the public welfare or for other charitable, scientific or educational purposes.
