# ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

# FLINCHUM-SCHLITT DEVELOPMENT II, L.L.C.,

a Florida limited liability company

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The undersigned, being above the age of eighteen (18) years and competent to contract, for the purpose of organizing a limited liability company pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization, and does hereby agree and certify as follows:

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this limited liability company shall be Flinchum-Schlitt Development II, L.L.C. (the "Company").

# ARTICLE II - COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

#### ARTICLE VIII - NON-LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

- 8.1 <u>Non-Liability</u>. A Manager of this Company, including any Member who shall be a Managing Member, shall not be personally liable to the Company or its Members for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a Manager (or Managing Member), except for liability:
  - (a) for a breach of the Manager's duty of loyalty to the Company or its Members;
  - (b) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of law;
  - (c) for a transaction from which the Manager derived an improper personal benefit; or
  - (d) under Section 608.4363(7), Florida Statutes (or any similar provision of any subsequent law enacted in Florida).
- 8.2 <u>Indemnification</u>. Each individual or entity who is or was a Manager (including any Managing Members) of the Company (and the heirs, executor, personal representatives, administrators, successors or assigns of such individual or entity) who was or is made a party to, or is involved in any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that such person is or was a Manager of the Company ("Indemnitee"), shall be indemnified and held harmless by the Company to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended. In addition to the indemnification

conferred in this Article, the Indemnitee shall also be entitled to have paid directly by the Company the expenses reasonably incurred in defending any such proceeding against such Indemnitee in advance of its final disposition, to the fullest extent authorized by applicable law, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended. The Company may, by action of the Manager, provide indemnification to such of the officers, employees and agents of the Company to such extent and to such effect as the Manager shall determine to be appropriate and authorized by applicable law. The rights and authority conferred in this Article shall not be exclusive of any other right which any person may have or hereafter acquire under any statute, provision of the Articles of Organization or Regulations of the Company, agreement, vote of Members or otherwise. Any repeal or amendment of this Article by the Members of the Company shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a Manager or officer existing at the time of such repeal or amendment.

#### ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT

This Company reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Organization, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the Members is subject to this reservation, which amendment or repeal shall only be effectuated by the unanimous written approval of all Members of the Company.

#### ARTICLE X - ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS

The Company shall adopt Regulations for the Company, which Regulations may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the business and affairs of the Company not inconsistent with these Articles of Organization, or Chapter 608, *Florida Statutes*.

#### ARTICLE XI - HEADINGS AND CAPTIONS

The headings or captions of these various Articles of Organization are inserted for convenience and none of them shall have any force or effect, and the interpretation of the various articles shall not be influenced by any of said headings or captions.
