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

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

LOST RIVER, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Operation of Company Act FS Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Company Act FS Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Company Act FS Chapter 608. Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles ôf Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be **LOST RIVER**, L.L.C. ("company").

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company shall be 110 South Sewall's Point Rd., Stuart, FL 34996.

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The company's existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV -- REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the state of Florida are: Stuart M. Lamb, 110 South Sewall's Point Rd., Stuart, FL 34996

ARTICLE V - CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The members of the company shall contribute to the capital of the company the cash or property set forth in Exhibit "A".

ARTICLE VI -- ADDITIONAL CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Each member shall make additional capital contributions to the company only on the unanimous consent of all the members.

ARTICLE VII - ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional members shall be admitted to the company except with the unanimous written consent of all the members of the company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the members. The company shall be managed by a manager in accordance with regulations adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. The managing member shall be indemnified by the company against all expenses and liabilities, including attorney's fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceedings or any settlement of any proceeding to which he may be a party or any which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been the managing member of the company, whether or not he is the managing member at the time such expenses are incurred, except when the managing member is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his duties, provided that in the event of settlement the indemnification shall apply only when the members approve such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interest of the company. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such managing member may be entitled.
