ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATIONS

R. J. BERSCH & COMPANY, LLC

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this limited liability company (the "Company") shall be R. J. BERSCH & COMPANY, LLC and its mailing address is 102 Wild Holly Lane, Longwood, Florida, 32779 and principal place of business address is 1407 E. Robinson Street, Orlando, Florida 32801.

ARTICLE II

COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

This Company shall commence existence on the date these Articles are filed with the Florida Department of State and shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the Regulations of the Company or according to law.

ARTICLE III

GENERAL PURPOSE: GENERAL POWERS

MANAGEMENT

<u>ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS</u>

Additional Members may be admitted from time to time on such terms and conditions as determined by Manager. No current Member has any preemptive rights.

ARTICLE VIII

DEATH, RETIREMENT, RESIGNATION, BANKRUPTCY, EXPLUSION, DISSOLUTION OF MEMBER

In the event of the death, retirement, bankruptcy, expulsion or dissolution of a Member or the occurrence of any other event, which terminates the continued membership of a Member in the Company, the Manager may continue the business of the Company without a vote of the Member so long as there is at least one remaining Member of the Company.
