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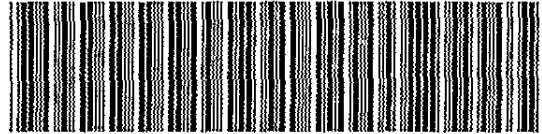

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
COYLE-BRAMHALL PROPERTIES, L.L.C.

The undersigned hereby forms and organizes a limited liability company pursuant to Section 608.407 of the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, and adopts the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company is:

COYLE-BRAMHALL PROPERTIES, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The limited liability company shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND ADDRESS

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE V - MANAGEMENT

The Limited Liability Company is to be managed by the members and the names and addresses of the managing members are:

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ARTICLE VI - ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

The members of the Company shall have the right to admit additional members by the unanimous vote of the members of the Company, and conditions of the admission of new members shall be governed by the Company's operating agreement.

ARTICLE VII - OPERATING AGREEMENT

The members of the Company shall hereafter adopt an operating agreement setting forth all the terms, provisions, conditions and covenants by which the Company will be governed. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Operating Agreement shall be vested in the Members of the Company by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE VIII - MEMBERS RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

The remaining members of the company shall, in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the Company's Operating Agreement, have the right to continue the business of the Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member of the company.

ARTICLE IX - INDEMNIFICATION

to the fullest extent permitted by law, the Company shall indemnify any person who was or is a party to any proceeding by reason of the fact that he/she is or was a manager or a managing member of the Company, or is or was serving at the request of the company as a manager, managing member, officer, employee or agent of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise against liability incurred in connection with such proceeding, including the appeal thereof, if he/she acted in good faith and in a manner he/she reasonably believed to be in, or not opposed to, the best interest of the Company and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, has no reasonable cause to believe his/her conduct was unlawful. The Company shall reimburse each person for all costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees, reasonable incurred by him/her in connection with any such liability in the manner provided for by law or in accordance with the Operating Agreement of the Company.

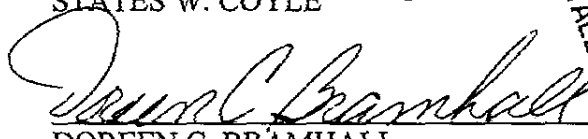
The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provision shall not exclude any other right to which he/she may be lawfully entitled, nor shall anything therein contain or restrict the right of the Company to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically provided for herein.

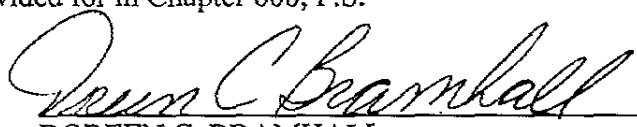
