



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

- (2) To generally engage in and carry on any business incidental thereto; to do all other things and to exercise any and all other powers of a company, by authority and by law, does or exercises; to construct, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire real estate and personal property of any nature, or any interest, therein, without limit as to amount or value, reasonably necessary or convenient to effecting or furthering any or all of the purposes and powers, including, ownership of real and intangible property, entering into contracts, investment in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, and carrying on any activity necessary or incidental to the accomplishment or furtherance of the purpose of the company, all in accordance with the provisions of Florida Statutes.



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
