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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF FUP, L.L.C.

The undersigned certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability dompanies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Articles and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME, PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS, AND MAILING ADDRESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be FUP, L.L.C. and its principal office address, mailing and corporate address shall be 5450 S. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any demestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or escind any of such contracts.

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- 5. To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers, and to carry out ill or any of the purposes, anumerated in these Articles and otherwise granted or annumentated by law, while sciing as agent, nominee, or attorney-in-fact for any persons or improvations, and perform any service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, frint stock company, association, partnership, firm, syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in this capacity or under this arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, extend the property and commercial interest of the property and to aid, assist, or participate in any lawful enterprise in connection with or incidental to the agency, impresentation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance it may lawfully of under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit.
- 6. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplianment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the firtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or partaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or piwers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.
