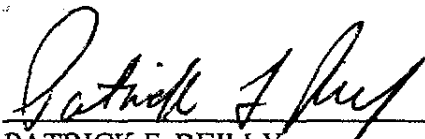
ARTICLE VII

REGULATIONS

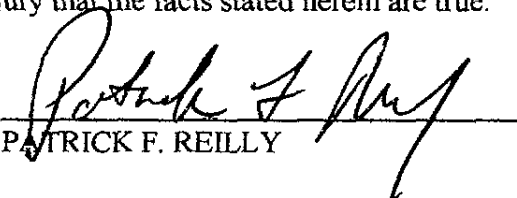
The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Articles of Organization or regulations of the Company is vested entirely in the members of the Company.
