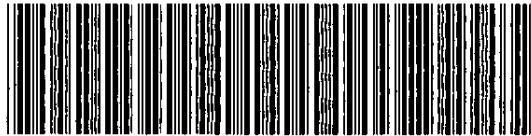



6. Adequate provision has been made for the satisfaction of any judgment or order that may be entered against the company in any pending lawsuit.




