ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

B. R. Pusser & Co., LLC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the Following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be for a pusser & Co., LLC and it shall carry on any lawful business.

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The street address of the principal office of the limited liability company is 1626 38th Ave. N., St. Petersburg, Fla. 33713 and the mailing address of the limited liability company shall be P.O. Box 530742, St. Petersburg, Fla. 33711.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The limited liability company shall commence its existence on the date these Articles of organization are filed by the Florid Department of State. - B. The fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the members entitled to vote and they authorize approve, or ratify such contract or transaction by vote or written consent; or
- C. The contract or transaction is fair and reasonable as to the limited liability company at the time it is authorized by the managers, managing members, a committee, or the

members.

- For purposes of paragraph 1(A) only, a conflict of interest transaction is authorized, approved, or ratified if it receives the affirmative vote of a majority of the managers or managing members, or of the committee, who have no relationship or interest in the transaction described in subsection 1, but a transaction may not be authorized, approved, or ratified under this section by a single manager of the manager-managed company or single member limited liability company. If a majority of the managers or managing members who have no such relationship or interest in the transaction vote or authorize, approve, or ratify the transaction, a quorum is present for the purpose dir action under this section. The presence of, or a vote cast by manager or managing member with such relationship or interest in the transaction does not affect the validity of any action taken under paragraph 1(A) if the transaction is otherwise authorized, approved, or ratified as provided in that subsection, but such presence or vote of those managers or managing members may be counted for purposes of determining whether the transaction is approved under other sections of this chapter.
- 3. For purposes of paragraph 1 (B) only, a conflict of interest transaction is authorized, approved, or ratified if it receiving the vote of a majority-in-interest of the members entitled to be counted under this subsection. Membership interests

The vote of those membership interests. however counted in determining whether is transaction is approved under other sections of this act. majority-in-interest of the members whether or not present, that are entitled to be counted in a vote on the transaction under this subsection constitutes a quorum for the purposes of taking action under this section.
