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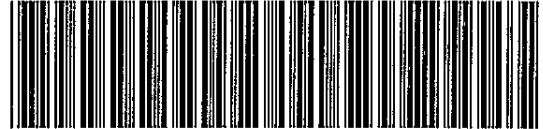

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be 3-J's Carpentry, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing address of the principal office and the street address of the principal office of the limited liability company is 45 SE 61st Court, Ocala, FL 34472.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The limited liability company is purposefully organized to operate for any and all lawful purposes.

ARTICLE IV-DURATION

ARTICLE VIII -- MEMBERS' RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

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The company shall not be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, STATE or dissolution of a member, or on the occurrence of any other FLORIDA event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the company, unless otherwise stated in the Operating Agreement or Bylaws, and only by a majority vote of the remaining members.

ARTICLE VIV -- MANAGEMENT

The limited liability company shall be initially managed by Joshua Lynn and shall continue to be managed by Joshua Lynn unless otherwise mandated in accordance with the Operating Agreement and/or Bylaws adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. 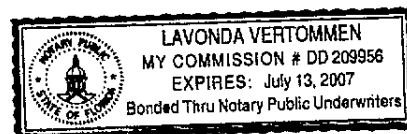




