ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF ST. FRANCIS VETERINARY CENTER, P.L.C.

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The undersigned, desiring to form a professional limited liability company finder and pursuant to Section 608 and 621 of the Florida Statutes, entitled the Florida Lipited Liability Company Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for such company.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the professional limited liability company, hereinafter referred to in these Articles as "St. Francis Veterinary Center, P.L.C." herein referred to as the "Company."

ARTICLE II ADDRESS

The Company's mailing address and street address of its principal place of business in Florida is 2319 Windfield Drive, Navarre, Florida 32566, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as may be designated by the members.

ARTICLE III DURATION/CONTINUATION

Beginning on the date these Articles of Organization are filed with the Florida Department of State, the period of the Company's duration shall be perpetual, unless terminated by the unanimous written agreement of all members or by the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member or upon the occurrence of any other event which terminated the continued membership of a member, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, or by amendment of these Articles of Organization providing for the continued existence of the Company subsequent to the foregoing events.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

The sole and specific purpose for which the Company is organized is to practice veterinary medicine in every aspect or otherwise and to manage a veterinary clinic.

In addition, the Company shall have unlimited power to engage in and do any lawful act concerning any or all lawful businesses for which professional limited liability companies may be organized according to the laws of the State of Florida, excluding banking and insurance, including all powers and purposes now and hereafter permitted by law to a professional limited liability company.

ARTICLE V MANAGEMENT

The business of the Company shall be managed by its members in proportion to their contributions to the capital of the Company as adjusted from time to time to properly reflect any additional contributions or withdrawals by the members. 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ARTICLE VI RESTRICTIONS ON MEMBERSHIP

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous consent. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the Company. A member's interest in the Company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with unanimous written consent of all members.

ARTICLE VII POWERS

All professional limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this professional limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of, the members of the Company. The Company may be managed by a Board of Directors and elect officers. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the Company by a unanimous vote of the members of the Company.

ARTICLE VIII REGULATIONS

Any amendment to these Articles of Organization shall be on such form prescribed by the Florida Secretary of State, containing such terms and provisions consistent with Sections 608 and 621 of the Florida Statutes, as shall be prescribed by the Department of State, and shall be signed and sworn to by all members of the Company. In the event a new member is added by such amendment, it shall also be signed by the member to be added.

The undersigned, being the original members of the Company, hereby acknowledge that, in accordance with Section 608.408(3) and 621, Florida Statutes, the execution of these Articles of Organization constitutes an affirmation under the penalties of perjury that the facts stated herein are true.
