ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF RINCONCITO LATINO III, L.L.C.

The undersigned hereby certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall be the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of such limited liability company.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be **RINCONCITO LATINO III, L.L.C.**, and its principal place of business shall be in the City of Miami, County of Dade, State of Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as may be designed by the members.

To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers and to carry out all or any of the purposes enumerated herein, otherwise granted or permitted by law, while acting as agent, nominee, or attorney-in-fact, for any persons or corporations, and perform any service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, joint stock company, association, partnership, fin-n, syndicate, individual or other entity, and in such capacity or under such arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extend the property and commercial interest thereof, and to aid, assist, or participate in any lawful enterprise in connection therewith or incidental to such agency, representation, or service, or to render any other service or assistance insofar as it lawfully may under the laws of the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit.
- 6. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others, incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 7. The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.
- 8. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit, the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under the laws of the State of Florida, lawfully carry on, exercise or do.

ARTICLE III CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

ARTICLE IV PROFITS AND LOSSES

1. <u>Sharing of Profits</u>. The members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company as follows, subject to adjustment to equal the proportion of the member's capital account to the total of all capital accounts of the Limited Liability Company at the time of the allocation of profits:

The distributive share of the profits shall be determined and paid to the members on the anniversary date of the commencement of business of the limited liability company.

2. <u>Losses.</u> All losses that occur in the operation of the limited liability company business shall be paid out of the capital of the limited liability company and the profits of the business and shared and allocated among the members in proportion to the balance of their capital accounts at the time of the allocation of losses.
