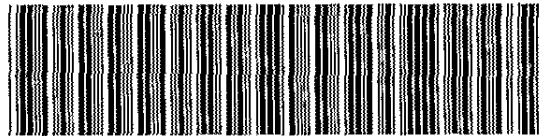


ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF
CBGB, LLC

The undersigned Member hereby makes, subscribes, and files these Articles of Organization for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act.

1. Name. The name of the limited liability company is CBGB, LLC.
2. Duration. The period of duration of the limited liability company is perpetual.
3. Principal Office. The mailing address and the street address of the principal office of the limited liability company is 481 N.E. 72 Street, Miami, Florida 33138.
4. Registered Agent and Office. The name and address of its initial registered agent in the State of Florida, whose Consent to Appointment as Registered Agent accompanies these Articles of Organization, is The Law Offices of Craig M. 5. Admission of Additional Members. Additional Members will be admitted only upon such terms as are unanimously agreed to by all Members entitled to a dividend upon dissolution or liquidation.
6. Continuity; No Right to Distribution on Withdrawal. The remaining Members of the limited liability company will have the right to continue the business upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a Member or occurrence of any other event, which terminates the continued membership of a Member in this limited liability company. No Member shall be entitled to receive a return of capital or other distribution upon withdrawal from this limited liability company or otherwise, except as otherwise provided in the Regulations of this limited liability company.
7. Management. The business of the limited liability company shall be conducted under the unanimous affirmative vote of the Members. The name and address of the Initial Managing Members are Brian T. Jordan and Carmel Ophir and their address is 481 N.E. 72 Street, Miami, Florida 33138.
