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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF PHILIP L. WATTERSON, M.D., LLC

The undersigned certifies that he has come together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. It is declared that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

I. NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be Philip L. - 4. To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets, and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation carrying on any kind of business of a similar nature to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of these Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of the rights and property so acquired.
- 5. The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under Florida laws, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

III. EXERCISE OF POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of the members of this limited liability company. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by a unanimous vote of the Members of the limited liability company.

IV. MANAGEMENT

This limited liability company shall be managed by at least one manager. The name and address of the persons who shall serve until a successor is elected and qualified are: Philip L. Watterson and Cherilynn J. Watterson, 4065 Mariner Boulevard, Spring Hill, FL 34609. Members shall have the right to change the number of managers by unanimous consent.

V. MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous consent. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company.

A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with the unanimous written consent of Members.

On the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business on the unanimous consent of the remaining voting members.

VI. CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contributions in the form of cash or property having a value of at least \$1000.00 shall be contributed to the limited liability company by the Members. Additional contributions may be made as required for investment purposes, as determined by majority consent of the Members. Members will make contributions in proportion to the membership interests.

VII. PROFITS AND LOSSES

- 1. <u>Profit Sharing.</u> The Members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company. Each Member shall be entitled to a proportionate distributive share of the profits. The distributive share of the profits shall be determined and paid to the Members on December 31 of each year unless otherwise agreed to by the Members.
- 2. <u>Losses</u>. All losses that occur in the operation of the limited liability company business shall be paid out of the capital of the limited liability company and the profits of the business, or, if these sources are insufficient to cover such losses, by the Members in proportionate shares up to the maximum amount of their capital contribution.

VIII. DURATION

This limited liability company shall have perpetual existence unless earlier dissolved in a manner provided by law, or as provided in the regulations adopted by the Members.

IX. CLASSES OF MEMBERS

The Members may create additional classes or groups of members having such rights, powers and duties as they may provide. The Operating Agreement may provide
