and all other certificates, instruments, and documents as are necessary, reasonable, or desirable to obtain title or convey title to any real or personal property whatsoever. The signature and execution of such documents shall clearly set forth that the execution is on behalf of the Company, and that the members are signing on behalf of the Company. These Articles may be amended or restated at any time by the vote of a majority in interest of the members, and such amendment or restatement shall be filed with the Florida Department of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 608.411 of the Act.

#### ARTICLE XII.

# Operating Agreement

An Operating Agreement shall be prepared and adopted to govern the internal affairs of the Company containing such provisions as the members consider necessary, reasonable, or desirable, except that no provision of such Operating Agreement may conflict with the provisions of these Articles unless permitted herein. The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal the Operating Agreement shall be set forth in the Operating Agreement, except that the initial form shall be approved by all of the members.
