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## ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company act. Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

### ARTICLE 1 - NAME



The Company also may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of an individual arising from the individual's status as a manager, officer, employee or agent of the Company, whether or not the Company would have power to indemnify the individual against the same liability under the law. All references in these Articles of Organization are deemed to include any emendment or successor thereto. Nothing contained in these Articles of Organization shall limit or preclude the exercise of any right relating to indemnification or advance of attorney fees and expenses to any such person by contract or in any other manner. If any word, clause of sentence of the foregoing provisions regarding indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Organization to "manager", "officer",

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"employee" and "agent" shall include the heirs, estates, executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons.
