ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION VOLTERRA DEVELOPMENT, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be VOLTERRA DEVELOPMENT, LLC ("Company").

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the initial principal office of the Company shall be 662 Willow Park Drive, Naples, Florida 34109.

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The Company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The Company's existence shall be perpetual unless the Company is earlier dissolved as provided in these articles of organization or in the Company's operating agreement.

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE V -- ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional members shall be admitted to the Company except with the written consent of the managing member of the Company. A member may transfer his or her interest in the Company as set forth in the operating agreement of the Company, but the transferree shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the Company or become a member unless all of the other members of the Company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approve of the proposed transfer by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE VI - WITHDRAWAL OF MEMBERS

A member of the Company may withdraw from the Company upon the unanimous prior consent of all the nonwithdrawing members of the Company.

ARTICLE VII - TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company shall be dissolved upon the occurrence of events specified in the Company's operating agreement.

ARTICLE VIII - MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be managed by the members in accordance with the operating agreement adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company. This operating agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with law or these articles of organization.
