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



ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
JUSTICE INSURANCE SERVICES, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be JUSTICE INSURANCE SERVICES, LLC, ("company").

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company is Apt. #203, 259 Palm Park Circle, Longwood, FL 32779.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these Articles of Organization are filed by the Florida Department of State or on another effective date as specified. 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ARTICLE VII – MEMBERS' RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS




