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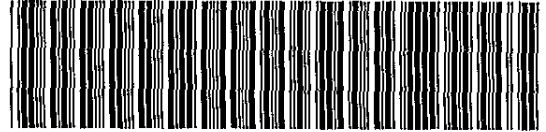

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION**

The undersigned certifies that he has associated himself for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. He further declares that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

**ARTICLE I**

**NAME, PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS, AND MAILING ADDRESS**

The name of the limited liability company shall be Christopher A. Young, P.L., and its principal office shall be located at 2612 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Panama City, County of Bay, State of Florida 32401, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the member may designate. The mailing address of the limited liability company is 2612 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Panama City, Florida 32401.

**ARTICLE II**

**PURPOSES AND POWERS**

In addition to the powers authorized by the laws of the State of Florida for limited liability companies, the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted, and which the limited liability company is authorized to transact, shall be as follows:

1. This Limited Liability Company is for the specific purpose of creating a law firm, and this Limited Liability Company will engage in the business of the practice of law as regulated by the Florida Bar.
2. In general, to carry on any and all incidental business; to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida and the Florida Bar, and to do any and all things set forth in these Articles to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.
3. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
4. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of

any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida or the Florida Bar.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing, permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under Florida laws and as permitted by the Florida Bar, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

### ARTICLE III

#### EXERCISE OF POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of, the member of this limited liability company. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by an unanimous vote of the members of the limited liability company.

### ARTICLE IV

#### MANAGEMENT

Management of this limited liability company is reserved to its members, whose names and addresses are as follows:

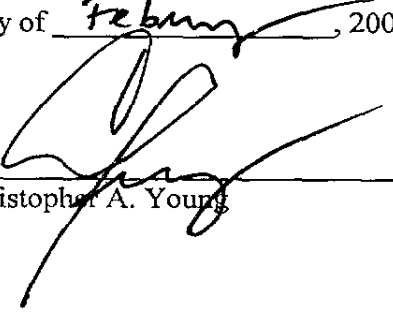
